Our Community Bank made a heartfelt community gesture by supporting Kyabram District Health Service to the tune of \$12,000 as the final piece of the puzzle in funding a much-needed nine seater bus for Sheridan Aged Care.

At a total cost of approximately \$72,000, the new vehicle will ensure Sheridan residents can enjoy safe and flexible outings whether it's attending community events, medical appointments or simply for accessible time with family. The rest of the funds were generously donated by private donors.

KDHS CEO Anne McEvoy said, "We're so grateful for Community Bank Kyabram's support. Having this bus will be life changing for Sheridan residents, giving them real access to community life. It's about social connection, health and wellbeing, and the simple joy of being part of things."

The support is another example of putting local people first and channelling profits back into projects that matter most.

"It's what community banking is all about, helping Kyabram grow. However, the model only works when customers support us in the first instance, then our profits can go back to impactful community projects," said Nattalie Joinbee, Community Bank Kyabram's Community Engagement Lead.

Garden Forum Held in Mental Health Week

In a proud moment for our community, the Kyabram Garden Club hosted the Annual Forum of the North-West Region of Garden Clubs for the very first time with strong local backing from us at Community Bank Kyabram.

When Kyabram Netball Association came to us with a plan to upgrade their club rooms, we didn't just see a request for paint, flooring, blinds and IT equipment, we saw a really clear purpose. This is for a club that:

- Has 180+ registered players and 58 teams across all ages
- A clear strategic plan and a team of volunteers making magic happen every week
- A commitment to women's sport and growing opportunities.

We provided support to one of the town's most loved events, the Ky RV Country Music Festival, which returned for its 11th and final year.

Led by President Allan Weeks and Secretary Cheryl Warne, the festival welcomed more than 300 motorhomes and caravans into Kyabram, creating a lively atmosphere filled with music, dancing and community connection.

The festival had become a mainstay of



Kyabram's events calendar, drawing visitors from across Victoria and beyond. Its popularity brought with it a significant boost for local businesses and tourism, while fostering community pride however the curtain fell for the final time this year.

Community Engagement Lead Nattalie Joinbee said, "Events like this are exactly why community investment matters. The Ky RV Country Music Festival has brought people together, driven economic benefit and strengthens the identity of our town".



Community Impact Funding Round



Community pride was in full swing as we distributed a total of \$18,249 of community investment funding to six outstanding local groups who are making a significant impact in the community.

Our AGM and Community Investment Showcase, held at the Kyabram Plaza Theatre, highlighted the power of community-driven projects, with funding awarded to the following groups:

Kyabram Blue Light Program	\$3,000
Kyabram Pony Club	\$5,000
All Breeds Society Spring Dairy Youth Show	\$2,500
KCLC – 8 Minutes (Stage 1 Development)	\$2,500
Goulburn Murray Community Leadership	\$4,250
Kyabram Fellowship	\$999

These grants reflect our company's ongoing commitment to creating meaningful local change, with each project selected for its potential to deliver lasting impact in areas such as youth engagement, regional leadership, education, wellbeing and community connection.

Volunteer Director and MC Alicia Cunningham hosted the event, with local customer Filipa joining the official proceedings to represent the customer community who make the model possible.

"Without customers like Filipa, we simply couldn't do this," said Branch Manager Mel Roberts. "Every dollar reinvested comes from local people choosing our branch. And thanks to that support, we've now given back over \$400,000 to our community and it continues to build."

The event marks the final round of community investment support for 2025. Community Bank Kyabram will now work alongside the latest recipients as they deliver their funded projects.

Community Engagement Lead Nattalie Joinbee added, "These groups are the real doers, and we get to back them. It's a privilege to help fund their efforts and watch their projects come to life."
